This proceeding was instituted under the Horse Protection Act, as amended (15 U.S.C. § 1821 et seq.)(HPA or Act), by a complaint filed by the Administrator of the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, United States Department of Agriculture (APHIS), on January 9, 2017, alleging that respondent Andrew Waites violated the Act. This decision is entered pursuant to the consent decision provisions of the Rules of Practice applicable to these proceedings (7 C.F.R. § 1.138).

Respondent Andrew Waites admits the jurisdictional allegations in the complaint and specifically admits that the Secretary has jurisdiction in this matter, neither admits nor denies the remaining allegations, waives oral hearing and further procedure, and consents and agrees to the entry of this decision, for the purpose of settling this proceeding. The complainant agrees to the entry of this decision.

Findings of Fact

At all times mentioned herein, Mr. Waites was a "person" and an exhibitor," as those terms are defined in the regulations issued pursuant to the Act (9 C.F.R. § 11.1 et seq.).

Conclusions of Law

The respondent has admitted the facts set forth above and the parties have agreed to the entry of this decision. Therefore, such decision will be entered.

Order

Respondent Andrew Waites is assessed a \$2,200 civil penalty, to be paid by check or money order, made payable to the "USDA/APHIS," indicating that the payment is in reference to HPA Docket No. 17-0089, and sent to:
