- 2. Consequently, this case is **dismissed**. APHIS's denial of the application for a USDA Animal Welfare Act license is AFFIRMED. Aaron Bloom is disqualified from being granted a USDA Animal Welfare Act license for a period of one year beginning today, July 30, 2015.
- 3. **Beginning July 31, 2016**, Aaron Bloom may apply for an Animal Welfare Act license.
