



U.S. Inflation Easing





U.S. Dollar Remains Elevated





Fertilizer Prices Lower, \$/Ton





World Stocks Less China, Million Metric Tons




Season Average Farm Prices, \$/Bushel



3-Crop Planted Area, Million Acres




Planted Area by Crop, Million Acres






2024 Winter Wheat Planted Acres Thousand Acres and Percent Change from Previous Year









U.S. Corn Supply, Billion Bushels









Soybean Supply, Billion Bushels




Soybean Use and Carry-out, Billion Bushels

Soy Oil Share of Crush Value and Meal Exports Trend Higher










