Codex Committee on Fish and Fishery Products (CCFFP)

The 36th Session of the CCFFP will meet by correspondence from October 7-11, 2024. The report adoption will take place virtually on Zoom on October 17, 2024, at 11:00 am CET (5:00 pm ET).
