Codex Committee on Residues of Veterinary Drugs in Foods (CCRVDF)

The 27th Session of the CCRVDF (CCRVDF27) will meet in Omaha, Nebraska, United States, from October 21-25, 2024. Physical Working Groups (WGs) will take place on October 20 for: Priority List of Veterinary Drugs for Evaluation/Re-evaluation by the Joint FAO/WHO Expert Committee on Food Additives (JECFA), Extrapolation of MRLs to one or more species, and Criteria and Procedures for the Establishment of Action Levels. The plenary sessions and the physical WGs will be webcast on YouTube in listening mode in English, French, and Spanish.
