# Joint FAO/WHO Expert Committee on Food Additives (JECFA)

- **JECFA97:** The JECFA monograph from the 97<sup>th</sup> Meeting has been officially published. JECFA97 evaluated the safety of titanium dioxide, including revising its specifications, and evaluated the safety of three groups of flavoring agents. - JECFA99: The JECFA monograph from the 99<sup>th</sup> Meeting has been officially published. JECFA99 evaluated the safety of the following food additives: butterfly pea flower extract, natamycin A, nisin, and polyglycerol esters of fatty acids, as well as four processing aids. JECFA99 also revised the specifications for ten flavoring agents.
